The people in the work are amalgamations that create a cohesive experience that seems strange and familiar.

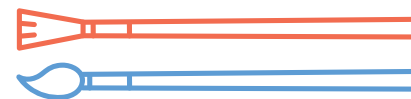

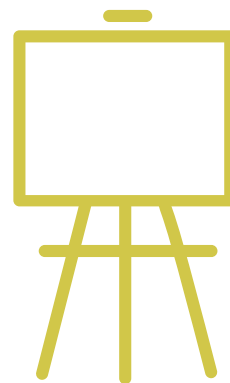

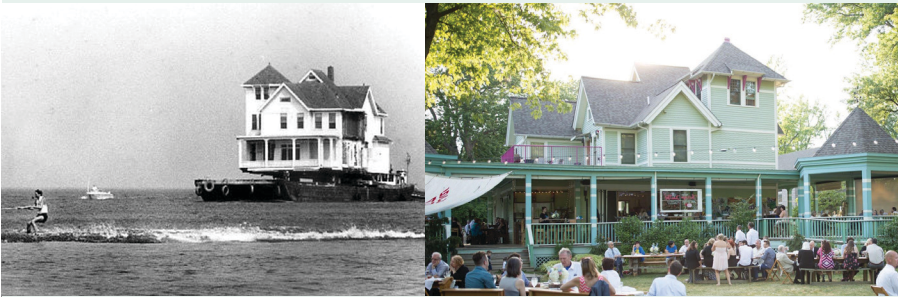
